Shays' Rebellion was the first major armed rebellion in the post-Revolution United States. In 1786, debt-ridden Massachusetts farmers under the leadership of Daniel Shays began closing courts and releasing debtors from prison. The rebellion was soon crushed by organized military action by the state of Massachusetts, but illustrated some serious problems in the fledgling republic.
